## STATE AND STATE QUALIFIER BID FORM 2006-2007

**Before** you and your Club bid for meets this season, please be able to answer **Yes** to the following requirements!

1. We have one or more Meet Directors that have taken and passed the Meet Directors exam, and a USAG professional member.
2. We will follow the State and National Rules & Policies when hosting awarded meets.
3. Our designated Meet Directors will read and become familiar with the 2006-2007 MI Rules & Policies booklet and attend a state required Meet Directors meeting as scheduled by the State Administrative Chairman.
4. We are aware that there are set entry fees, team fees, award regulations, and postmark deadlines that must be followed.
5. Our Meet Directors are aware that they have ***“Meet Mailing Deadlines”*** for getting information to competing clubs and judges.
6. Our Meet Directors will see that the gym is nicely decorated, cleaned, and properly organized for the enjoyment of all involved.
7. Our gym has properly updated, safe equipment, and mats according to the R & P.
8. We will order state medals from MI-USAG and be responsible for getting appropriate ribbons from any local company of our choice.
9. \*We will send \$1.00 competition fee to MI-USAG for each competing gymnast for State Qualifiers and State Meets at Levels 5 and 6 and \$2.00 for Levels 7, 8, 9 and 10. Along with the ***CF***, we will send a copy of the sanction report form and scores within 48 hours and the financial report form within 2 weeks to Douglas A. Rowe, State Administrative Chairman.
10. \*We will mail legible scores and a copy of the certificate of sanction to all competing clubs, and the appropriate board representative within 48 hours.
11. \*We will mail \$1.00 competition fee to Kathy Koeth-Shufflin (Regional Chairman) and a copy of the sanction report form within 24 hours.
12. \*We will mail a copy of the sanction report form to the USAG within 24 hours.
13. **We will use team entry fees collected ENTIRELY for team awards.**
14. We will award team trophies in the amount of 40% for team entries at State Qualifiers and State Meets with a MINIMUM of 3 team trophies (Top 3 individual scores per event count toward team scores). Level 10 State Meet team trophies will be awarded in the amount of 50%.
15. We will have our gym available Saturday and Sunday (TWO FULL DAYS) for the meets we bid for in case the numbers are large for the particular meet.

16. Clubs that host a state meet falling on Mother's Day will schedule the meet to be completed by Saturday night or early afternoon on Sunday.
17. We will charge \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for seniors and children for admission to all State Qualifying Meets, and \$7.00 for adults and \$5.00 for seniors children for admission to all State Meets, for consistency throughout the State. ***\*Subject to Change:*** Any changes to these charges the meet director must apply to the State Administrative Committee for a variance.
18. We will take the utmost care that our meet is a positive experience for all involved.
19. We will provide the judges with the correct meals as stated in the R&P
20. We provide a coaches table if there is more than one session.
21. Our facility will provide adequate Restroom facilities.
22. A fee of \$2.00 will be charged to the pro members that do not have their USAG pro number with them at check in, then ask host clubs to take time to look it up online.

There couldn't be a more fitting end to a story than the one written at this years Junior Olympic National Championships. For the fifth consecutive year Region 5 dominated nationals by earning the OVERALL TEAM TITLE reserved for the best overall region in the USA. For the 6<sup>th</sup> time in the last 8 years we captured 5 of the 8 possible age group titles. Simply Amazing!

This year there is no story about the underdogs overcoming adversity to win. This year we were as strong on paper as any team we have ever had represent Region 5. With that being said however, being good on paper means nothing (just ask the Dallas Mavericks). What matters most is performing when it counts and perform we did!

The weekend started with a 1-2 Junior and Senior A punch. Both age groups were crowned champions. The Senior As were unstoppable taking the top 5 all around spots while setting an all time team scoring record of 192.75. Senior Bs followed suit to cap off the first day of competition with 3 wins for Region 5. Sunday saw the Jr Cs and Senior Ds pull off exciting and emotional wins. What is really amazing is that we had legitimate shots at winning the Jr. D and Senior C age groups also (both ended up 3<sup>rd</sup>).

National All Around Champions were aplenty: Amanda Jetter-CGA Jr A, Venessa Zamarripa- Midwest Twisters- Sr. A, MacKenzie Caquatto- Aerial- Jr C, Gina Nuccio- Arena- Sr B. Not bad ... 50% of the National Champions are from Region 5 ... Not bad at all.

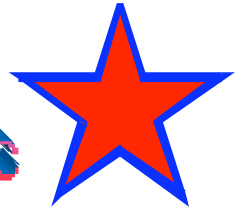
